EX PARTE ORIGINATING SUMMONS


LET ALL PARTIES CONCERNED attend before a judge in chambers, at the Law
Courts, George Town, Grand Cayman on the *28th* day of *July* 1999,
at *9.30 a.m.* o'clock, on the hearing of an application on behalf of the Attorney
General for an Order that :-

1. The sums of
 - a. U.S. \$280,000 and all interest accruing thereon and
 - b. U.S. \$17,012.52, any additional deposit made and any
interest accruing thereon in account number 21186 in the name of
Global Marketing Group at the Cayman National Bank, Elgin
Avenue, George Town;

which are held respectively by the Cayman Islands Government and the Royal
Cayman Islands Police, pursuant to a criminal investigation into allegations of
Obtaining Property by Deception contrary to section 235(1) of the Penal Code and
Money Laundering contrary to section 23 of the Proceeds of Criminal Conduct
Law, 1996 against Global Marketing Group and Eric Christian Ralls being
property of which there is reason to believe was obtained by or is the proceeds of
the commission of criminal offences, be kept and held by the Court until some
person establishes a right thereto to the satisfaction of the Court within twelve
months from the date of the Order herein granted. Failing which on the expiration
of twelve months from the date of the making of this order, such shall vest in the
Financial Secretary for the use of the Islands.

2. Items of IBM Think Pad Laptop computer and IBM Aptiva computer both used in the commission of the above mentioned criminal offences be similarly held.
3. Such further or other order as the Court may deem fit.
