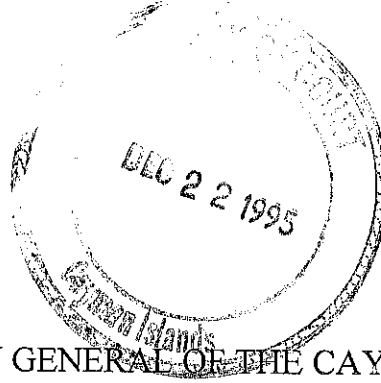

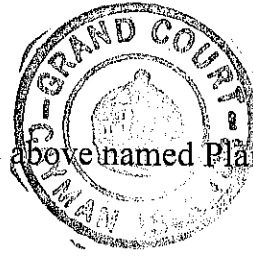

THIS WRIT OF SUMMONS has been issued against you by the above named Plaintiff in respect of the claim set out on page 3.

Within 14 days after the service of this Writ on you, counting the day of service, you must either satisfy the claim or return to the Court Office, PO Box 495G, George Town, Grand Cayman, the accompanying Acknowledgment of Service stating therein whether you intend to contest these proceedings.

If you fail to satisfy the claim or return the Acknowledgment within the time stated, or if you return the Acknowledgment without stating therein an intention to contest the proceedings, the Plaintiff may proceed with the action and judgment may be entered against you forthwith without further notice.

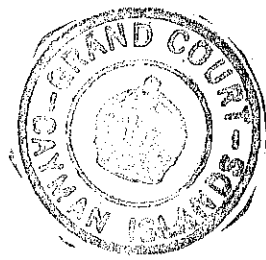

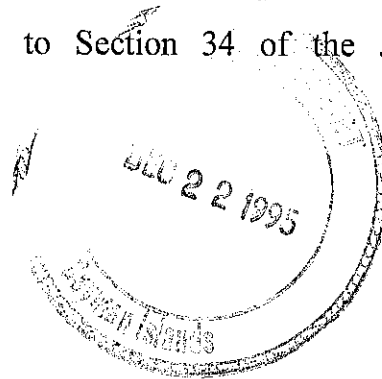


CLAIM



THE PLAINTIFF'S CLAIM is for:

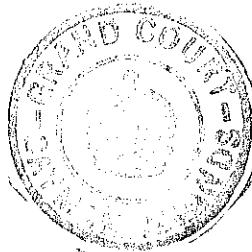
- (1) Against the First Defendant an account on the footing of wilful default or otherwise in respect of the sale, payments and dealings set out or referred to in paragraphs 19.12 to 19.20 of the Statement of Claim ("the English Statement of Claim") served by Even Wahr-Hansen in the action brought by him in the Chancery Division of the English High Court of Justice the short reference to the record whereof is CH-1994-W-No.2564.
- (2) Against the First and Second Defendants an account on the footing of wilful default or otherwise in respect of the payments and dealings set out or referred to in paragraphs 23.6 (a) (b) and (d) of the English Statement of Claim.
- (3) Against the First and Second Defendants an account on the footing of wilful default or otherwise in respect of the payments and dealings set out or referred to in paragraphs 23.13(e) to (g) of the English Statement of Claim.
- (4) Interest (compounded with yearly rests or otherwise) pursuant to the Court's inherent jurisdiction and/or pursuant to Section 34 of the Judicature Law (Revised).
- (5) All necessary accounts and inquiries.
- (6) Further or other relief.



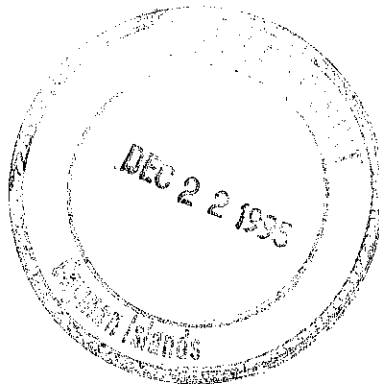
(7) Costs.
