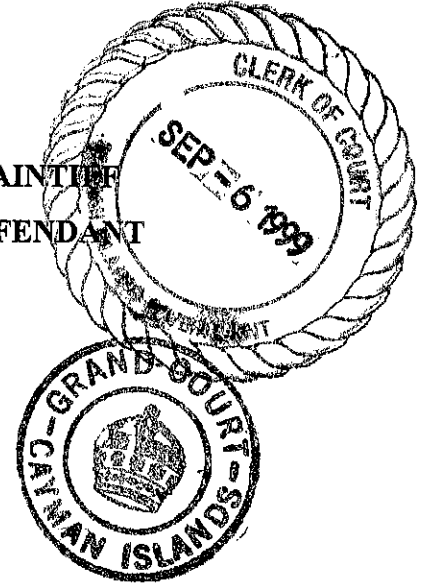

LET THE DEFENDANT, within fourteen (14) days after service of this Summons upon him, counting the day of service, return the accompanying Acknowledgement of Service form to the Courts Office at P.O. Box 495 G, George Town, Grand Cayman.

BY THIS SUMMONS, which is issued on the Application of the Plaintiff, Angelica Campbell of West Bay, Grand Cayman, Cayman Islands, the Plaintiff claims against the Defendant that, an Order for custody, care and control of the minor child, namely **RICHARD MICHAEL POWELL, Jr.**, born on the 1st day of April, 1999 in accordance with Section 7 of the Guardianship and Custody of Children Law (1996 Revision).

2. That the natural father, Richard Michael Powell, Snr. deliver up custody of the said infant to the natural mother forthwith, together with baby clothes and baby care items.

3. That an injunction be granted restraining the natural father, Richard Michael Powell, Snr. and members of his family, in particular one Vivinne Powell from approaching within 100 yards of, and generally harassing, stalking, threatening or annoying in any way, the Plaintiff, Angelica Campbell or the said infant child.
4. That this Honourable Court may grant such further and other relief as this Honourable Court deems fit and proper.

**DIRECTIONS FOR ACKNOWLEDGEMENT OF SERVICE
OF ORIGINATING SUMMONS**

The accompanying form of *Acknowledgement of Service* should be completed by an Attorney acting on behalf of the Defendant or by the Defendant if acting in person. After completion it must be delivered or sent by post to the Law Courts, P.O. Box 495 G, George Town, Grand Cayman.

Notes for Guidance

1. Each Defendant (if there are more than one) is required to complete an Acknowledgement of Service and return it to the Courts Office.
2. For the purpose of calculating the period of 14 days for acknowledging service, a writ served on the Defendant personally is treated as having been served on the day it was delivered to him.
3. Where the Defendant is sued in a name different from his/her own, the form must be completed by him/her with the addition in paragraph 1 of the words "sued as (the name stated on the Originating Summons)".
4. Where the Defendant is a **FIRM** and an attorney is not instructed, the form must be completed by a **PARTNER** by name, with the addition in paragraph 1 of the description "Partner in the firm of (.....)" after his/her name.
5. Where the Defendant is sued as an individual **TRADING IN A NAME OTHER THAN HIS/HER OWN**, the form must be completed by him/her with the addition in paragraph 1 of the description "trading as (.....)" after his/her name.
6. Where the Defendant is a **LIMITED COMPANY** the form must be completed by an Attorney or by someone authorised to act on behalf of the Company, but the Company can take no further step in the proceedings without an Attorney acting on its behalf.
7. Where the Defendant is a **MINOR** or a **MENTAL PATIENT**, the form must be completed by an Attorney acting for a guardian ad litem.
8. A Defendant acting in person may obtain help in completing the form at the Courts Office.



In the case of a limited company, "residence" means its registered principal office.
