## STATEMENT OF CLAIM

1. The Plaintiff claims that the Defendant on or about the 6<sup>th</sup> October 1998, obtained fill material from the Plaintiff on a credit account.
2. The Defendants said credit account with the Plaintiff is now more than 90 days in arrears, in the amount of CI\$17,738.85.
3. Despite several requests, the Defendant refused and still refuses to pay the sum of CI\$17,738.85 and the sum of CI\$17,738.85 remains due and payable.
4. The Defendant is also indebted to the Plaintiff in the sum of CI\$10,000.00 being the balance paid to the Defendant by the Plaintiff for real estate whereby the Defendant failed to enter into a contract to sell the same to the Plaintiff.

2. The sum of CI\$10,000.00.
2. Interest thereon at the prescribed rate from 27<sup>th</sup> July 1999 to date.
