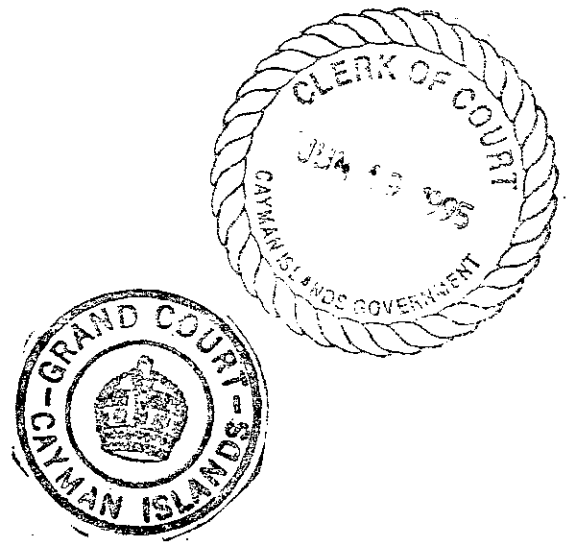
AND THE PLAINTIFF CLAIMS against the Defendant as drawer:-
