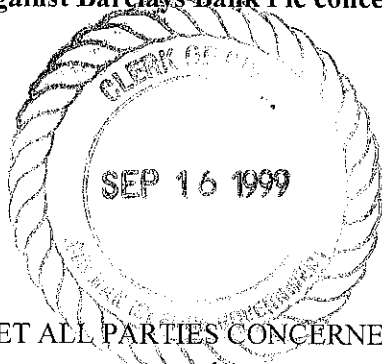

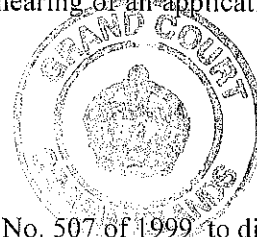

EX PARTE ORIGINATING SUMMONS


