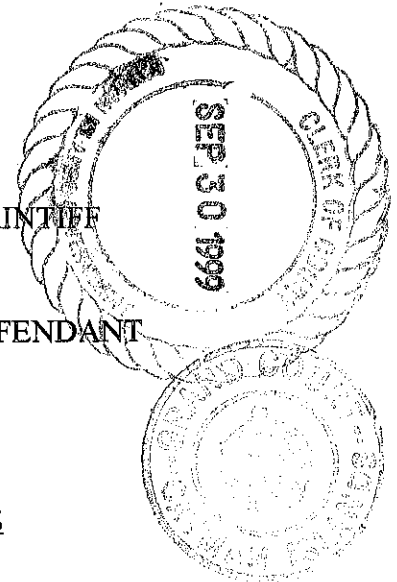

THIS AMENDED WRIT OF SUMMONS has been issued against you by the above-named Plaintiff in respect of a claim set out the next page.

Within fourteen (14) days after service of this Writ on you, counting the day of service, you must either satisfy the claim or return to the Court Office, P.O.Box 495G, George Town, Grand Cayman, the accompanying Acknowledgement of Service stating therein whether you intend to contest these proceedings.

If you fail to satisfy the claim or to return the Acknowledgement within the time stated, or if you return the Acknowledgement without stating therein an intention to contest the proceedings, the Plaintiff may proceed with the action and judgement may be entered against you forthwith without further notice.

NOTE - This Writ may not be served later than 4 calendar months (or, if leave is required to effect service out of the jurisdiction, 6 months) beginning with the date of issue unless renewed by order of the Court.


SPECIAL INDORSEMENT

1. The plaintiff is a local company with licence to sell ready mixed concrete
2. The defendant is a builder in Bodden Town, Newlands.
3. On the 15th July, 1999 the defendant ordered ready mixed concrete valued at \$4,147.50, to be delivered on the 16th July and gave the plaintiff a Cayman National Bank cheque as payment for the concrete to be supplied.
4. On the 16th July, 1999 the plaintiff delivered the concrete to the defendant and lodged the cheque in its account but on the 20th July, 1999 the said cheque was returned to the plaintiff and marked, "refer to drawer".
5. The plaintiff demanded the defendant to pay cash and retrieve his cheque but he has failed to do so.
