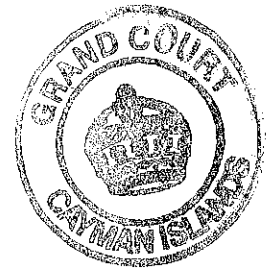

ORIGINATING SUMMONS

LET THE DEFENDANT, within 14 days after service of this Summons upon him, counting the day of service, return the accompanying Acknowledgment of Service form to the Courts Office, P.O. Box 495, George Town, Grand Cayman, Cayman Islands.

By this Summons, which is issued on the application of the Plaintiffs (Amada Lopez Cantera and Josef Vogler, in their capacity as trustees of the Hutterli Trust, whose address is care of Messrs. Holland & Knight, Attorneys at law, 701 Brickell Avenue, P.O. Box 015441, Miami, Florida, United States of America), the Plaintiffs seek the following relief and the determination of the Court of the following questions, namely: -

- (1) a declaration as to whether the trustees of the Hutterli Trust hold the assets of that trust upon the trusts of the agreement made on 12th June 1995 and amended on 11th August 1995 and, if not upon the trusts of that agreement, upon what trusts the assets are held;

- (2) a determination as to what property is held on the trusts of the Hutterli Trust;
- (3) a direction as to whether, and if so, to whom the trustees should furnish accounts;
- (4) all necessary and consequential orders and directions;
- (5) further or other relief; and
- (6) an order that the Plaintiffs' reasonable costs of this Summons be paid in any event on an indemnity basis out of the assets of the Hutterli Trust.
