

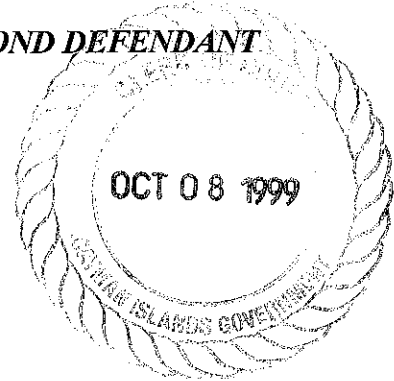

If you fail to satisfy the claim or return the Acknowledgement within the time stated, or if you return the Acknowledgement without stating therein an intention to contest the proceedings the Plaintiff may proceed with the action and judgement may be entered against you forthwith without further notice.



STATEMENT OF CLAIM

1. The Plaintiff is and was at all material times a resident of George Town and the owner and driver of Mitsubishi Space Wagon licensed 51 477.
2. The Defendant was at all material times the owner of Ford Explorer motor vehicle licensed number .
3. The Second Defendant was at all material times the driver of the aforesaid Ford Explorer motor vehicle and drove with the consent and/or authority of the First Defendant.
4. On the 24th day of July 1997 the Plaintiff was driving her aforesaid motor vehicle along the Eastern Avenue, George Town, Grand Cayman in a north easterly direction heading towards West Bay Road, when the Second Defendant so negligently drove the First Defendant's aforesaid motor vehicle along the said road, in the vicinity of the Champion House Restaurant, that it collided head on with the Plaintiff's vehicle.

Particulars of Negligence

- (a) Driving at a speed which was excessive in the circumstances;
- (b) Driving on the wrong side of the road;
- (c) Failing to keep any or any proper look-out or to have any or any sufficient regard for the users of the road;
- (d) Overtaking or attempting to overtake without first ascertaining or ensuring that it was safe so to do;
- (e) Driving along the said road without paying any or any sufficient regard to the condition of the road;
- (f) Colliding head-on into the vehicle which the Plaintiff was driving;
- (g) Failing to stop, or slow down or to swerve or in any other way so to manage or control his said motor vehicle as to prevent the collision.

5. By reason of the matters aforesaid the Plaintiff sustained injuries and suffered loss and damage.

Particulars of Injuries

- (a) Tenderness over the left parietal region;
- (b) Severe headaches;
- (c) Severe and sustained back pain;
- (d) Laceration of the right elbow;
- (e) Laceration of the right knee;
- (f) Contusion;
- (g) Spasm in lower back muscles and hamstring muscles;
- (h) Cartilage damage to right patella.


