



one half of the proceeds of the policy.

6. That if indeed such policy is to be reinstated and in that event, the named beneficiary is to be changed to reflect both parties as beneficiaries instead of the Respondent's mother.
7. That there be no Order as to the cost of the proceedings.
8. That all legal aid in favour of the Petitioner be now determined, she now no longer being a person eligible under the Poor Persons (Legal Aid) Law.
9. The amount of US\$ 36,000.00 paid to the Respondent for medical expenses on 22nd December 1997 and CI\$ 10,000.00 paid to the Petitioner on <sup>some</sup> ~~debt~~ <sup>debts</sup> are to be taken into account as having been paid from the sums awarded above. *A. Smellie*
10. On that basis the balance of CI\$ 6,445.93 is to be equally divided between the parties and so ~~is~~ also any further interest to be paid on the fixed deposit. *A. Smellie*
11. The amount finally to be distributed will be as set out in the schedule hereto
