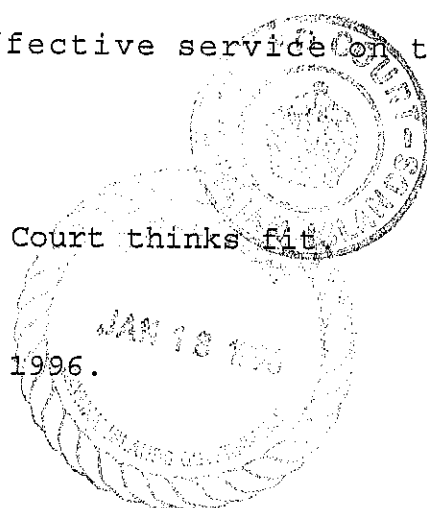
LET ALL PARTIES attend before a Judge of the Grand Court in
