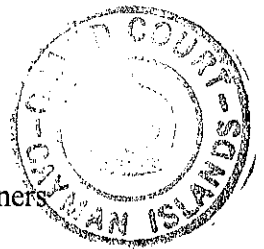

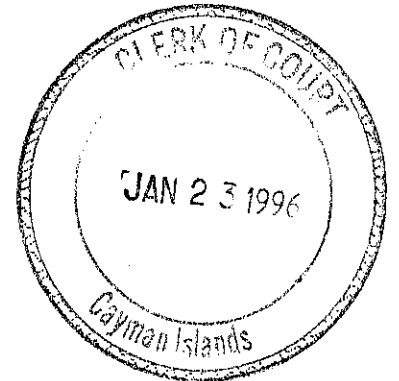

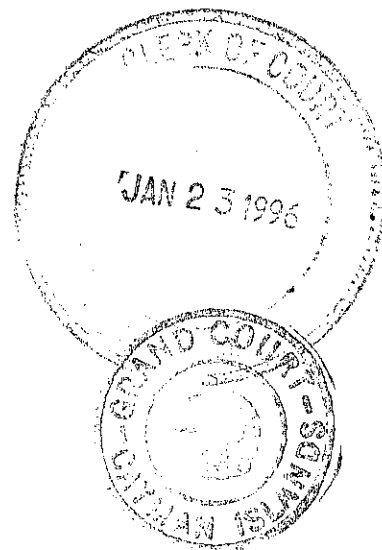
defence Counsel in Criminal Cases Numbers 5308-5314/95, Regina vs. Steven Francis Desnoes et al.
