

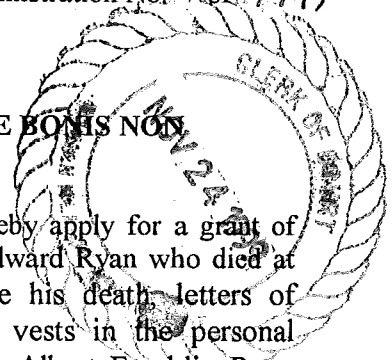

**APPLICATION FOR GRANT OF ADMINISTRATION DE BONIS NON
Succession Law, Section 3(7))**



I, Albert Burke Ryan of P.O. Box 168, Stake Bay, Cayman Brac, hereby apply for a grant of letters of administration de bonis non of the estate of the late John Edward Ryan who died at Cayman Brac on the 25th day of September 1923, intestate. Since his death letters of administration of all the estate which by law devolves on and vests in the personal representative of the said deceased was committed and granted to Albert Franklin Ryan (grand-son) of the deceased, by the Grand Court of the Cayman Islands on the 17th day of January, 1984, which grant now remains on record (copy attached). The said Albert Franklin Ryan, after intermeddling in the estate and effects, died on or about the 7th day of May 1998 (copy of death certificate attached) without having completed administration..

And I annex hereto my affidavit in support of my application which swears to the death of the late John Edward Ryan and Albert Franklin Ryan.

BOND

I, Albert Burke Ryan, declare myself (and my successors) to be bound unto the Financial Secretary of the Islands in the sum of CI\$ 150,000.00 *NS*.

Dated this 17 day of Nov. 1999 and sealed with my seal.

The condition of this obligation is that if the above named does, when lawfully called upon in that behalf, make or cause to be made a true and perfect inventory of the said estate and does exhibit the same in the Probate Registry whenever lawfully called upon so to do and does well and truly administer the said estate according to law and does make or cause to be made a just account and distribution account thereof whenever lawfully so required and, if, hereafter any other will of the deceased may be propounded, to yield up the letters of administration *de bonis non* to the Probate Registry, then this obligation shall be void and of no effect, but shall otherwise remain in force and effect.


BOND OF SURETIES
