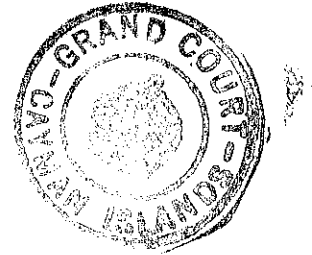
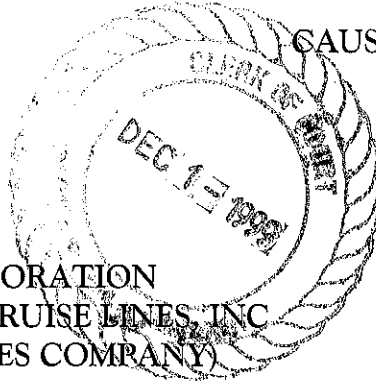

THIS WRIT OF SUMMONS has been issued against you by the above-named Plaintiff in respect of the claim set out on the next page.

Within *14 days* after the service of this Writ on you, counting the day of service, you must either satisfy the claim or return to the Court office, P.O. Box 495, George Town, Grand Cayman, the accompanying Acknowledgement of Service stating therein whether you intend to contest these proceedings.

If you fail to satisfy the claim or to return the Acknowledgement within the time stated, or if you return the Acknowledgement without stating therein an intention to contest the

proceedings, the Plaintiff may proceed with the action and judgment may be entered against you forthwith without further notice.

Issued this 1st day of December 1999.

NOTE - This Writ may not be served later than 4 calendar months (*or, if leave is required to effect service out of the jurisdiction, 6 months*) beginning with the date of issue unless renewed by order of the Court.

INDORSEMENT OF CLAIM

The Plaintiff ("Carnival") claims against the Defendant an indemnity together with all costs incurred alternatively such contribution as may be just pursuant to the Torts (Reform) Law (1996 Revision) arising out of a claim made against Carnival in proceedings commenced in the Circuit Court of the 11th Judicial Circuit in and for Dade County in Florida and entitled Edwin L. Mathews and another v Carnival Cruise Lines, Inc. ("the United States Proceedings") wherein one Mr. Edwin Mathews and his wife being passengers on board Carnival's vessel "The Destiny" claimed damages for negligence and breach of contract against Carnival for serious injuries sustained by Mr. Mathews on or about 5 December 1996 whilst disembarking in George Town Harbour from a tender owned and operated by the Defendant herein and contracted to transport Carnival's passengers from "The Destiny" to shore. The United States Proceedings were compromised by the payment of US\$1.3million in settlement on or about 19 October 1998 with no admission of liability by Carnival **AND** Carnival is entitled to and claims an indemnity and costs alternatively a contribution in respect of all sums which Carnival has paid and incurred as set out above on the grounds that Mr. Mathew's injuries were caused by the negligence of the Defendant and/or its servants and agents. Alternatively Carnival claims and is entitled to damages for breach of contract and/or negligence on the part of the Defendant. Further Carnival claims all costs incurred by Carnival and will also seek interest pursuant to Section 34 of the Judicature Law (1995 Revision) on all amounts found to be due to Carnival at such rate and for such period as the Court thinks fit.

AND THE PLAINTIFF CLAIMS:

1. A declaration that it is entitled to be indemnified by the Defendant as aforesaid.
2. Judgment for any amount that may be found due from the Defendant to the Plaintiff.
3. Further or in the alternative, damages for breach of contract and/or negligence

4. Costs
5. Interest on such sums at such rate and for such period as may be just pursuant to Section 34 of the Judicature Law (1995 Revision).
6. Further and/or other relief
