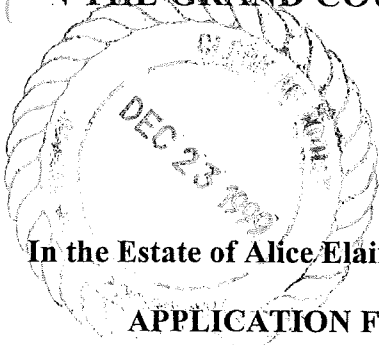

APPLICATION FOR LETTERS OF ADMINISTRATION DE BONIS NON

(Succession Law, Section 3(7))

I, Franklin Alroy Ryan, of 8704 North Packwood Avenue, Tampa, Florida, U.S.A., hereby apply for a grant of letters of administration de bonis non of the estate of the late Alice Elaine Ryan who died at Tampa, Florida, a married woman, on the 24th day of May, 1992.

Administration in the estate of the said Alice Elaine Ryan was granted by this Honourable Court on the 3rd day of February 1993 to her husband, my father, Albert Franklin Ryan, who died on the 7th day of May 1998 in Tampa, Florida, having intermeddled in the estate but without having completed its administration.

And I annex hereto my affidavit in support of my application and the certificate of death of the late Albert Franklin Ryan. The whole, or substantially the whole of the estate on these islands consists of real property the value of which is approximately CI\$ 3,750.




BOND

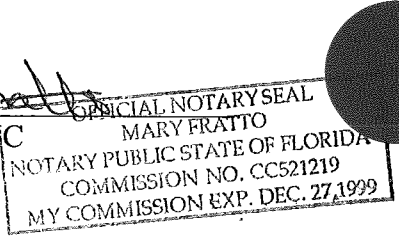
