

1. That this Honourable court do sanction and permit the Sale by private Treaty by the Plaintiff of all that property registered in the Cayman Islands Land Register with absolute title and being particularly known as Registration Section Prospect Park (Spotts) Block 25B Parcel 375 ("the Property") as Chargee with a power of sale over the Property.
2. That the Defendant and any other person occupying the Property do, within 28 days of this Order, vacate the Property and take all appropriate steps to give the Plaintiff vacant possession of the Property.
3. That the Plaintiff do have to issue a writ of possession in relation to the Property at the expiry of the 28 days referred to in paragraph 2 above.
4. Such further or other relief as this Honourable Court may deem appropriate.

AND LET THE DEFENDANT within 14 days after service of this summons on him counting the day of service; return the accompanying Acknowledgement of Service to the Courts office.
