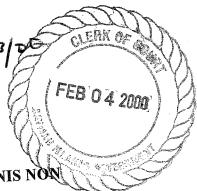

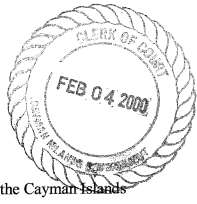

APPLICATION
FOR LETTERS OF ADMINISTRATION DE BONIS NON

I, JOSEPH LORENZO JACKSON of West Bay, Grand Cayman hereby apply for a grant of letters of administration de bonis non of the estate of the late JAMES HERMAN JACKSON, deceased of West Bay, Grand Cayman who died on or about the 15th day of August, 1964 intestate and to whose estate on the 5th day of January, 1965 letters of administration of all the estate which by law devolves on and vests in the personal representative of the said deceased was committed and granted to NELLA V. JACKSON, lawful daughter of the deceased, by the Grand Court of the Cayman Islands on the 5th day of January, 1965 which grant now remains on record, who after intermeddling in the estate and effects, died on or about the 28th day of August, 1993 leaving part thereof unadministered.

I annex hereto my affidavit in support of my application, a certified copy of the grant of letters of administration to Nella V. Jackson and the certificate of death of the late NELLA VERONA BANKS, whose maiden name was Jackson and who is the same person as the NELLA V. JACKSON to whom letters of administration were previously granted. Also attached in support of this application are five affidavits of renouncement of letters of administration de bonis non. Two of the renouncements are made by the surviving children of the deceased, being NORA HERMINA JACKSON and HENRY IRVIN JACKSON. Three of the renouncements are made jointly by the other grandchildren of the deceased, whose entitled parents are also deceased and who would have had prior rights.

And I declare myself bound unto the Financial Secretary of the Cayman Islands in the sum of CI\$80,000.00.

Dated this 31st day of January, 2000.

The condition of this obligation is that if the above named do, when lawfully called upon in that behalf, make or cause to be made a true and perfect inventory of the said estate and do exhibit the same in the Probate Registry whenever called upon so to do and do well and truly administer the said estate according to law and do make or cause to be made just account of and distribution account thereof when lawfully so required and, if, hereafter any will of the deceased may be propounded, to yield up the letters of the administration de bonis non to the Probate Registry, then this obligation shall be void and of no effect, but shall otherwise remain in full force and effect.
