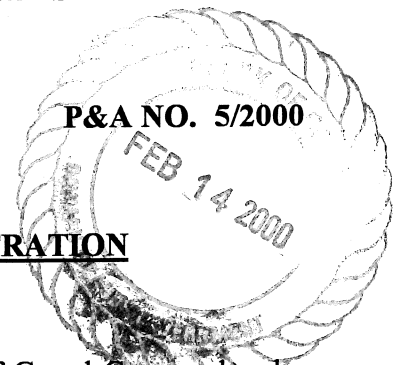

but shall otherwise remain in full force and effect.


