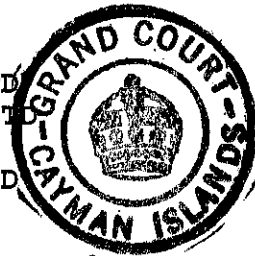

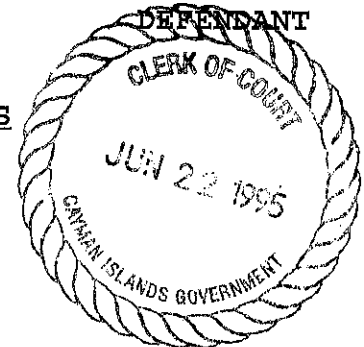

Within [14 days] after the service of this Writ on you, counting the day of service, you must either satisfy the claim or return to the Court Office, P.O. Box 495G, George Town, Grand Cayman, the accompanying Acknowledgement of Service stating therein whether you intend to contest these proceedings.

If you fail to satisfy the claim or to return the Acknowledgment within the time stated, or if you return the Acknowledgment without stating therein an intention to contest the proceedings, the Plaintiff may proceed with the action and judgment may be entered against you forthwith without further notice.

Issued this *21st* day of June, 1995.

NOTE - This Writ may not be served later than 4 calendar months (or, if leave is required to effect service out of the jurisdiction, 6 months) beginning with the date of issue unless renewed by order of the Court.

1. The Plaintiff's claim is for the sum of US\$7,750.00 being the balance of commission due to the Plaintiff from the Defendant following the sale of unit No. 45, Villas of the Galleon on the 20th April 1993.
2. Interest on the said sum of US\$7,750.00 from the 20th April 1993 to the date hereof at the rate of 8 3/8% per annum being: US\$757.54 and continuing thereafter at a daily rate of US\$2.08 per day until judgment or soon of payment.
3. Costs.

If, within the time for returning the Acknowledgment of Service, the Defendant pays the total amount claimed of US\$8,507.54 and CI\$350.00 in respect of costs and fees further proceedings will be stayed. The money must be paid to the Plaintiff or his Attorney.

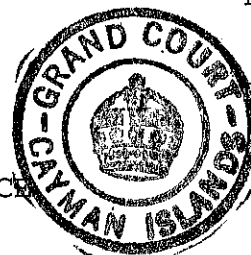
