Succession Law, Section 23 (1)




I, Mrs. Ng Kwan Suk Hing of Flat A1, 16<sup>th</sup> Floor, Evergreen Villa, No. 43 Stubbs Road, Hong Kong, the sole Executrix appointed by the High Court of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region of the estate of the late Mr Ng Chung, surviving the deceased, being over the age of twenty-one years and not having renounced Probate, which said Grant of Probate was made on the 7th day of October 1999, and the said Grant of Probate, together with the Last Will and Testament annexed hereto, HEREBY APPLY for Resealing of the Grant of Probate of the estate of the late Mr Ng Chung and undertake that in the event of a Resealed Grant being made to me:-

- (a) within six months of the Resealed Grant of Probate, I will prepare a true Inventory of the said estate in the Cayman Islands and exhibit and file the same in the Probate Registry; and
- (b) within one year of such Resealed Grant of Probate, I will arrange to have the assets comprising the said estate in the Cayman Islands administered according to the directions, if any, of the Court and file in the Probate Registry a general accounting for the whole of the assets of the said Cayman Islands estate.
