

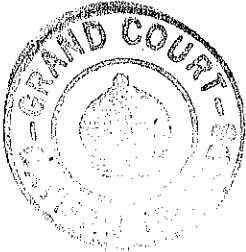

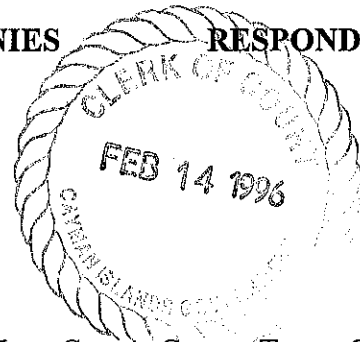

ORIGINATING SUMMONS



LET ALL PARTIES attend before the Judge in Chambers, at the Law Courts, George Town, Grand Cayman on the ^{7th} day of *March* 19⁹⁶, at ^{2.15 PM} o'clock on the hearing of an application by the Applicant for an Order that:-

1. The Applicant be restored to the Register of Companies on payment within seven days of all reinstatement fees and penalties to the Registrar of Companies and thereon the Applicant is to be deemed to have continued in existence as if its name had not been struck off the Register.
2. A duly sealed copy of this Order be served forthwith upon the Registrar of Companies and be advertised once in the Cayman Islands Gazette.
3. Such further relief as this Honourable Court deems fit.

AND LET THE RESPONDENT within 14 days after service of this summons on him counting the day of service, return the accompanying Acknowledgement of Service to the Courts office.

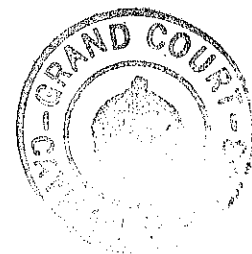
