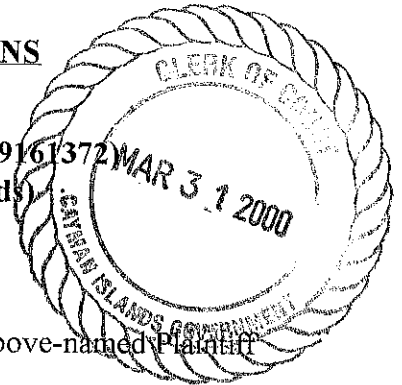

If you fail to satisfy the claim or to return the Acknowledgement within the time stated, or if you return the Acknowledgement without stating therein an intention to contest the proceedings, the Plaintiff may proceed with the action and judgement may be entered against you forthwith without further notice.


SPECIAL INDORSEMENT

1. The Plaintiff is a local Company with a licence to build and sell homes
2. The 1st defendant is the father of the 2nd defendant who lives at Moon Bay Drive, Newlands while the father lives in Boliers, off Walkers Road.
3. On the 6th October, 1999, the defendants entered into an agreement to purchase a house and land, Parcel 284 Block 28B Savannah, from the plaintiff for a total of \$132,250.00, inclusive of \$250.00 for valuation.
4. On the 12th November, 1999 the defendants, with a mortgage from Barfinco, paid the plaintiff \$125,000.00 and promised to pay balance of \$7,250.00, that afternoon with a loan already approved by Barclays Bank.
5. The plaintiff delivered the transfer documents to the defendants who had the property recorded in their names but failed to pay the balance as agreed and despite several demands, have failed to pay.

Wherefore the plaintiff claims:

1. The balance due \$7,250.00
2. Interest at the rate of 7 7/8 % p.a. from the date of Judgement until payment
3. Costs to be taxed if not agreed
