

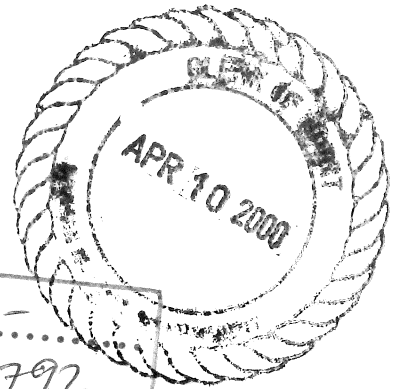

APPLICATION FOR RESEALING LETTERS OF ADMINISTRATION WITH WILL ANNEXED

Succession Law, Section 23 (1)

I, Paul Davidson Knowles of Mareva House, 4 George Street, New Providence, Bahamas, am the Administrator appointed by the Chief Justice of the Supreme Court of the Bahamas of the estate of the late John Angus Campbell, surviving the deceased, being over the age of twenty-one years and not having renounced Probate, which Letters of Administration with Will Annexed were made on the 13th day of September, 1995, and which said Letters, together with the Certificate of Death annexed hereto, HEREBY APPLY for Resealing Letters of Administration with Will Annexed of the estate of John Angus Campbell and enclose my Affidavit in that behalf and undertake that in the event of such Resealed Letters being made to me:-

- (a) within six months of the Resealed Letters of Administration with Will Annexed, I will prepare a true Inventory of the said estate in the Cayman Islands and exhibit and file the same in the Probate Registry; and
- (b) within one year of the Resealed Letters of Administration with Will Annexed, I will administer the assets comprising the said estate in the Cayman Islands according to the Will and directions, if any, of the Court and will file in the Probate Registry a general accounting for the whole of the assets of the said Cayman Islands estate.
