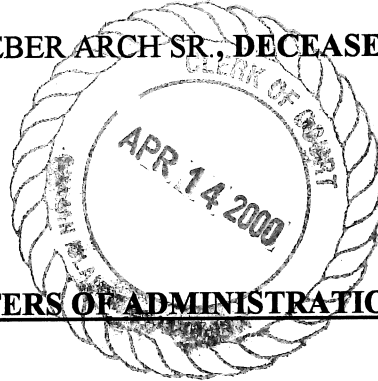

We, RICHARD E. ARCH of P.O. Box 165 GT, Grand Cayman, Cayman Islands and DAVID R. ARCH of P.O. Box 570 GT, Grand Cayman, Cayman Islands hereby apply for a Grant of Letters of Administration De Bonis Non of the estate of JAMES HEBER ARCH SR., late of George Town, Grand Cayman, Cayman Islands who died on or about the 12th day of April, 1943 intestate and to whose estate on the 30th day of January, 1947, Letters of Administration of all the estate which by Law devolves on and vests in the Personal Representatives of the said deceased was committed and granted to FORTESQUE E. ARCH. and EDWARD R. ARCH both of George Town, Grand Cayman, Cayman Islands by the Grand Court of the Cayman Islands which Grant now remains on record. After intermeddling in the estate and effects the said FORTESQUE E. ARCH died on or about the 8th day of October, 1971 and the said EDWARD R. ARCH died on or about the 26th day of December, 1980 leaving a part thereof unadministered.
