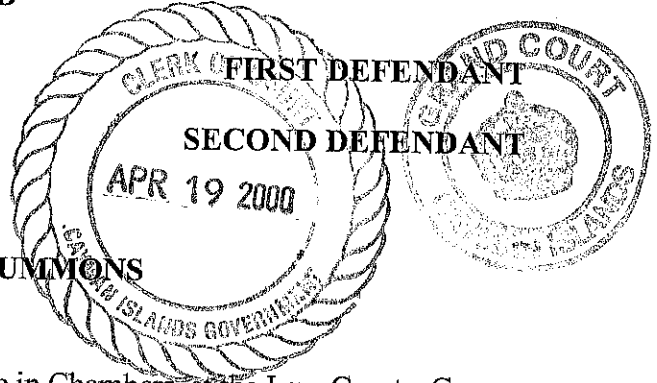

LET THE DEFENDANT attend before the Judge in Chambers, at the Law Courts, George Town, Grand Cayman on the 26 day of MAY 2000, at 9-30 o'clock on the hearing of an application by the Plaintiff for the following orders:

1. That this Honourable Court doth sanction and permit the sale by private treaty of all that land and property registered in the Cayman Islands Land Register and being particularly known as Registration Section West Bay North West Block 4E Parcel 557H4 by the Plaintiff as Chargee with a power of sale over the Property.
2. That the Defendant and any other person occupying the Properties do, within 28 days of this Order, vacate the Properties and take all appropriate steps to give the Plaintiff vacant possession of the Properties.
3. That this Honourable Court shall give directions with regard to the price for the sale of the Properties.
5. Such further or other relief as this Honourable Court may deem appropriate.

LET THE DEFENDANT, within 14 days after service of this Summons on him, counting the day of service, return the accompanying Acknowledgment of Service to the Courts Office, P.O. Box 495G, George Town, Grand Cayman.
