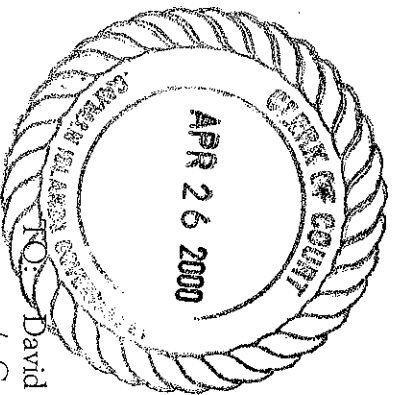

WRIT OF SUMMONS

THIS WRIT OF SUMMONS has been issued against you by the above-named Plaintiff in respect of the claim set out on the next page.

Within 14 days (or such longer period as the Court may specify in granting leave to effect service out of the jurisdiction) after the service of this Writ on you, counting the day of service, you must either satisfy the claim or return to the Court Office, P.O. Box 495G, George Town, Grand Cayman, the accompanying Acknowledgment of Service stating therein whether you intend to contest these proceedings.

If you fail to satisfy the claim or to return the Acknowledgment within the time stated, or if you return the Acknowledgment without stating therein an intention to contest the proceedings, the Plaintiff may proceed with the action and judgment may be entered against you forthwith without further notice.

Issued this 25th day of April 2000.

NOTE - This Writ may not be served later than 4 calendar months (or, if leave is required to effect service out of the jurisdiction, 6 months) beginning with the date of issue unless renewed by order of the Court.

THE PLAINTIFFS CLAIM:

1. Damages against the Defendants jointly and severally for breach of a building contract made in writing between the Plaintiffs and the First and Second Defendants alternatively the Second Defendant on or about August, 1998.
2. Damages against the Defendants jointly and severally for negligence arising out of and in connection with the Defendants conduct of the building contract referred to at paragraph 1 above.
3. Interest on such sums and for such periods at such rates as the court deems just in the circumstances.
4. Indemnity costs as provided for in the contract referred to at paragraph 1 above.
5. Further and/or other relief.
