3. That there be such further Order as the Court deems fit.

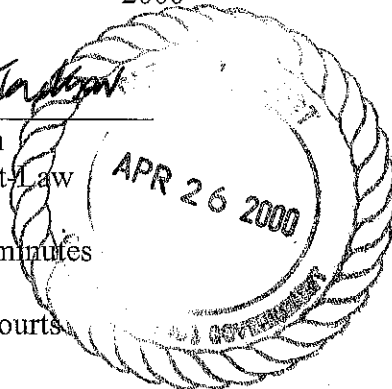



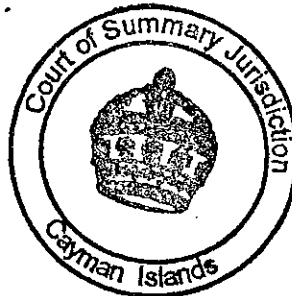
