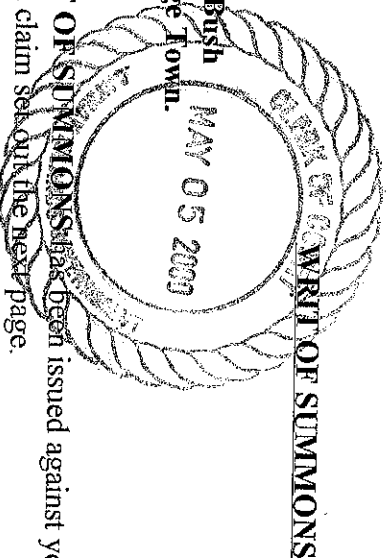

**THIS WRIT OF SUMMONS has been issued against you by the above-named Plaintiff** in respect of a claim set out on the next page.

**Within** fourteen (14) days after service of this Writ on you, counting the day of service, you must either satisfy the claim or return to the Court Office, P. O. Box 495G, George Town, Grand Cayman, the accompanying Acknowledgement of Service stating therein whether you intend to contest these proceedings.

If you fail to satisfy the claim or to return the Acknowledgement within the time stated, or if you return the Acknowledgement without stating therein an intention to contest the proceedings, the Plaintiff may proceed with the action and judgement may be entered against you forthwith without further notice.

Issued the 5th day of May, 2000.

**NOTE** - This Writ may not be served later than 4 calendar months (or, if leave is required to effect service out of the jurisdiction, 6 months) beginning with the date of issue unless renewed by order of the Court.

### STATEMENT OF CLAIM

1. The plaintiff is a Canadian Company involved in the business of printing and supplying printed materials.
2. The defendant is a Caymanian who operates a business known as "Images by Tara Bush" and was at all material times a customer of the plaintiff Company from which she ordered printed materials for which she paid after receipt thereof.
3. However, on the last three occasions on which the defendant ordered printed materials which she received them, she failed to pay, namely,
  - i. On or about 19th January, 1999 the defendant ordered an amount of 1999 calendars with "Cayman Motorsports" inscription which were supplied on the 28th and 29th January, 1999 at a cost (including shipping) of \$US 5,490.00 of which the defendant paid only US\$2,500.00;
  - ii. On or about the 15th February, 1999, she ordered program covers with "Cayman Motorsports Association" inscription which were supplied on the 22nd February, 1999 at a cost of US\$1,905.00. (including shipping); and
  - iii. On or about the 4th March, 1999, she ordered Bumper Stickers with "Cayman Motorsports Association" inscription which were supplied on the 11th March, 1999 at a costs of US\$530.00 (including shipping).
4. Invoices were sent to the defendant for payment on numerous occasions and although she made several promises to pay, the last being by e-mail on 10th February, 2000 when she promised to 'send the check on Friday', she has failed to pay
5. And, as of the date of the issuance of this writ, the defendant owes to the plaintiff the principal sum of US\$5,425.00
6. In addition to the principal sum due as set out above, the plaintiff is entitled to interest from the date of delivery of the goods, the rate of interest being that established pursuant to the Judicature Law (1995 Revision). Interest of US\$472.82 on the principal sum is also due as of the date of the issuance of this proceeding. The particulars of interest are as set out in the schedule attached to the Statement of Claim.

**AND the plaintiff claims:**

1. US\$5,425.00 principal as pleaded above



- iv. The prescribed rate of interest on US\$5,425.00 from 1/4/00 to 5/5/00 was 8% per annum
- v. The date from which interest accrues from the date of delivery of the goods
- vi. The total interest claimed as at the date of issuance of this Writ of Summons is \$472.82
- vii. The amount of interest accruing each day following the issue of this Writ is \$1.19.
