

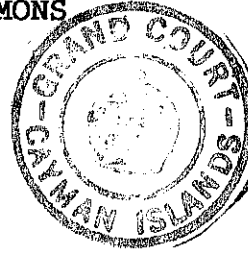

THIS WRIT OF SUMMONS has been issued against you by the above-named Plaintiff in respect of the claim set out on the next page.

Within [14 days] after the service of this Writ on you, counting the day of service, you must either satisfy the claim or return to the Court Office, PO Box 495G George Town, Grand Cayman the accompanying Acknowledgement of Service stating therein whether you intend to contest these proceedings.

If you fail to satisfy the claim or to return the Acknowledgment within the time stated, or if you return the Acknowledgment without stating therein an intention to contest the proceedings, the Plaintiff may proceed with the action and judgment may be entered against you forthwith without further notice.

NOTE - This Writ may not be served later than 4 calendar months (or, if leave is required to effect service out of the jurisdiction, 6 months) beginning with the date of issue unless renewed by order of the Court.

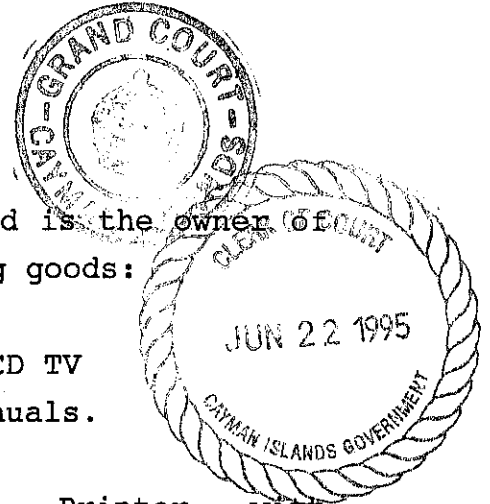

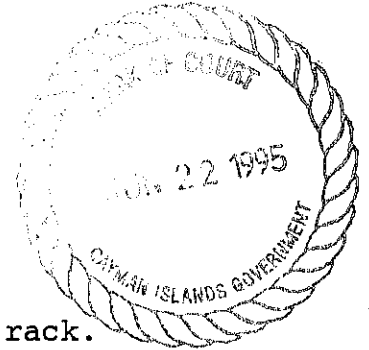
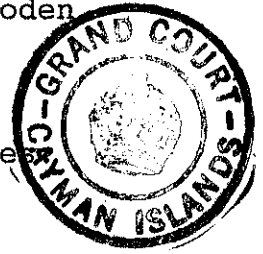
STATEMENT OF CLAIM

1. At all material times the Plaintiff was and is the owner of and entitled to possession of the following goods:

- (1) One Compaque Presario Computer CD TV
S/N # 56447HLM70702 with manuals.
- (2) One HP Deskjet 500 Colour Printer with
Leads/Cartridges.
- (3) One Surgearresters.
- (4) Twelve CD's music/computer programs
or more plus one container of private information
disks.
- (5) One VHS video recorder with remote control.
- (6) One Colour television with remote control.
- (7) Numerous Soft furnishings:
Bed linen, old/new sheets
Towels, white/colour
Pillows
Miscellaneous items
Two bedspreads (Woods)
- (8) One Electric blender with attachments.



- (9) One Set of silver plated dinner service in wooden box.
- (10) One Set of cut glass (6) Waterford wine glasses.
- (11) Several Miscellaneous items.
- (12) One Mongoose mountain bike (black).
- (13) Two Outside chairs and table.
- (14) Two Suitcases (blue/brown).
- (15) One Set of Woods mugs (6) on wooden rack.
- (16) One Spice rack with spices.
- (17) Other small items, ornaments, etc.



("The Goods")

- 2. On the 13th day of June 1995 the Defendant acting by herself or through her servants and/or agents wrongfully removed The Goods from the matrimonial home at 2 Sunrise Apartments, South Sound, Grand Cayman and delivered them into the possession of IMP Agency Ltd of Red Bay, Grand Cayman.
- 3. The Defendant has instructed IMP Agency Limited to forward The Goods on to her in Canada.
- 4. As a result of the Defendant's aforesaid actions the Plaintiff has suffered loss and damage.

AND THE PLAINTIFF claims:

- 1. A declaration that The Goods are the property of the Plaintiff.

2. An injunction to restrain the Defendant whether by herself or by her respective servants or agents or any of them from doing the following acts or any of them, that is to say, removing from the jurisdiction of this court or from disposing of, or transferring, assigning, or dissipating, or diminishing or in any way whatsoever dealing with The Goods.
3. The delivery of The Goods or their value and damages consequent upon the wrongful interference with the same by their detention.
4. Alternatively to (2) herein damages.

The total value of The Goods is CI\$4200.00.

5. Costs.

The Plaintiff further claims interest pursuant to Section 34 of the Judicature Law for such period and at such rate as the Court shall deem just.
