



APPLICATION FOR GRANT OF PROBATE OF A WILL
(Succession Law, Section 3(7))



- (b) within one year of such Grant to us, we will administer the said estate according to the tenor of the Will and directions, if any, of the Court and file in the Probate Registry a general accounting for the whole of the assets of the said estate.
