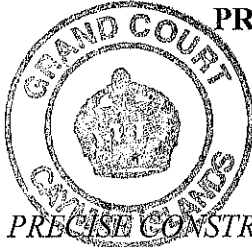

THIS WRIT OF SUMMONS has been issued against you by the above-named Plaintiff in respect of the claim set out on the next page.

Within [14 days] after the service of this Writ on you, counting the day of service, you must either satisfy the claim or return to the Court Office, PO Box 495G, George Town, Grand Cayman, the accompanying Acknowledge of Service stating therein whether you intend to contest these proceedings.

If you fail to satisfy the claim or to return the Acknowledgement within the time stated, or if you return the Acknowledgement without stating therein an intention to contest the proceedings, the Plaintiff may proceed with the action and judgment may be entered against you forthwith without further notice.

Issued this 7th day of June, 2000.

NOTE - This Writ may not be served later than 4 calendar months (or, if leave is required to effect service out of the jurisdiction, 6 months) beginning with the date of issue unless renewed by order of the Court.

STATEMENT OF CLAIM

1. The Defendant is a company duly registered under the laws of the Cayman Islands and carries on business in the Cayman Islands having its registered office at P.O. Box 237, West Bay, Grand Cayman.
2. The Plaintiff's claim is for the payment of the balance of the cost of work done and materials supplied by the Plaintiff to the Defendant at the Defendant's request in the total sum of CI\$5,065.00, full details of which have been supplied to the Defendant.

AND THE PLAINTIFF claims:-

1. Under paragraph 2 hereof the sum of CI\$5,065.00.
2. Interest in the sum of CI\$129.54 calculated at the rate of 7 3/8 % per annum from 2nd day of January, 2000 to the date of issue herein.
3. Continuing interest until judgment or sooner payment pursuant to Section 34 of the Judicature Law at the daily rate of CI\$1.02.
4. Costs.

N.B. These proceedings will be stayed if within fourteen (14) days of service hereof the Defendant makes payment to the Plaintiff's Attorneys-at-Law of the liquidated sum herein of CI\$5,065.00, together with costs in this action in the sum of CI\$400.00.
