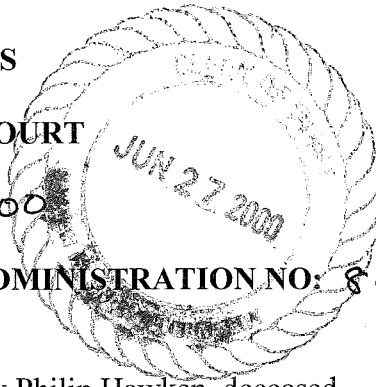

**APPLICATION FOR RESEALING GRANT OF PROBATE OF A WILL**

Succession Law, Section 23.(1)

I, William Anthony Hawken, 66 St George's Square, London, SW1V 3QT, United Kingdom am the Executor appointed by the High Court of Justice in England of the Estate of the late Henry Philip Hawken, surviving the deceased, being over the age of twenty-one years and not having renounced Probate, which said Grant of Probate was made on the 18<sup>th</sup> day of February, 1999, and the said Grant of Probate with the Will annexed, together with the Certificate of Death, are annexed hereto, HEREBY APPLY for Resealing of the Grant of Probate of the estate of Henry Philip Hawken and enclose my Affidavit in that behalf and undertake that in the event of a Resealed Grant being made to me:-

- (a) within six months of the Resealed Grant of Probate, I will prepare a true Inventory of the said estate in the Cayman Islands and exhibit and file the same in the Probate Registry; and
- (b) within one year of the Resealed Grant of Probate, I will administer the assets comprising the said estate in the Cayman Islands accordingly to the directions, if any, of the Court and will file in the Probate Registry a general accounting for the whole of the assets of the said Cayman Islands estate.
