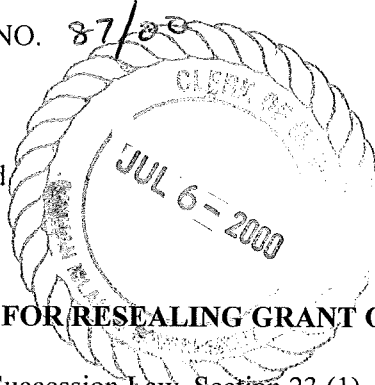

APPLICATION FOR RESEALING GRANT OF PROBATE

Succession Law, Section 23 (1)

We, Walkers of P. O. Box 265, George Town, Grand Cayman, Cayman Islands, on behalf of John Ernest Bryan Scanlan, David Aaron Landau and Kenneth Peter Collins, the Executors appointed by the High Court of England and Wales of the estate of the late James Mackie, surviving the deceased, being over the age of twenty-one years and not having renounced Probate, which said Grant of Probate was made on the 17th day of June, 1999, and the said Grant of Probate, together with the Certificate of Death, is annexed hereto, HEREBY APPLY for Resealing of the Grant of Probate of the estate of James Mackie and enclose the Affidavit of the Executors in that behalf and undertake that in the event of a Resealed Grant being made to the Executors:-

- (a) within six months of the Resealed Grant of Probate, we will prepare a true Inventory of the said estate in the Cayman Islands and exhibit and file the same in the Probate Registry; and
- (b) within one year of such Resealed Grant to the Executors we will arrange to have the assets comprising the said estate in the Cayman Islands administered according to the directions, if any, of the Court and arrange for the Executors to file in the Probate Registry a general accounting for the whole of the assets of the said Cayman Islands estate.
