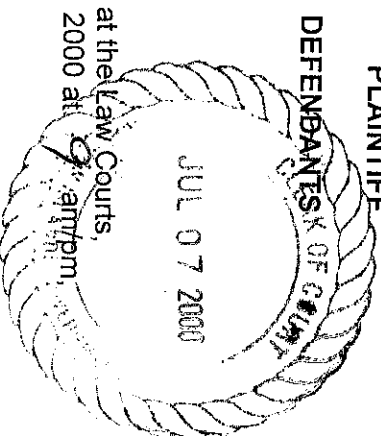

4. Interest pursuant to section 34 of the Judicature Law.
