

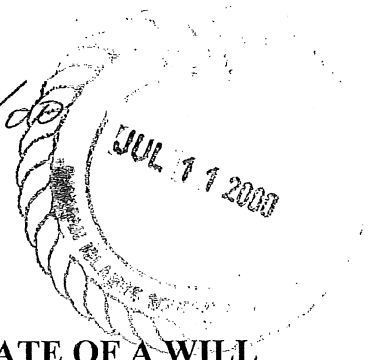

APPLICATION FOR GRANT OF PROBATE OF A WILL
(Succession Law. Section 3 (7))

- b. within one year of such grant to me, I will administer the said Estate according to the tenor of the Will and directions, if any, of the Court and file in the Probate Registry a general accounting for the whole of the assets of the said Estate.
