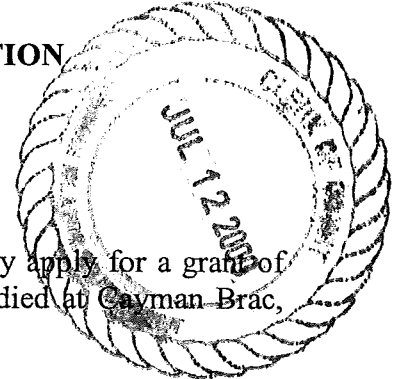

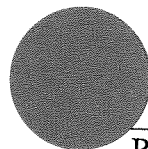
I declare myself (and my successors) to be jointly and severally bound unto the Financial Secretary of the Islands in the sum of CI \$ 120,000.


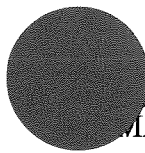
BOND OF SURETY
