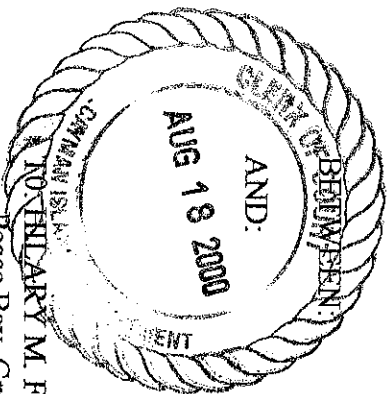

ORIGINATING SUMMONS



Mr Justice Henderson

LET the Respondent attend before a Judge in Chambers at the Law Courts, George Town
Grand Cayman, B. W.I on the *25* day of *August*, 2000 at *9:30* o'clock in the

fore/afternoon on the hearing of an application by the Applicant who seeks the
determination of the Court on the following questions, namely an Order :-

1. That the Applicant be appointed guardian for the said Hilary M. Forde ("the patient") and over his estate and effects with the following powers conferred upon her:
 - a) to control and manage the property of the patient.
 - b) to sell, exchange, charge or otherwise dispose of or deal with any property of the patient.
 - c) to invest the proceeds of sale or any other monies belonging to the patient in such securities as the Applicant for the time being is authorised by law to invest trust funds.
 - d) to deposit into and withdraw from any account at any bank or Credit Union in the Cayman Islands such of the patient's monies as may be necessary for the proper maintenance and care of the patient.

2. The Applicant shall keep proper accounts of his administration and management of the property of the patient and whenever required by the Court to do so shall file in Court copies of such account.
3. The cost of this application and the cost of the guardian incidental to and consequent upon the Order shall be paid from the estate and property of the patient.

AND LET THE RESPONDENT within 14 days after service of this Originating Summons, counting the day of service, return the accompanying Acknowledgment of Service to the Courts Office.
