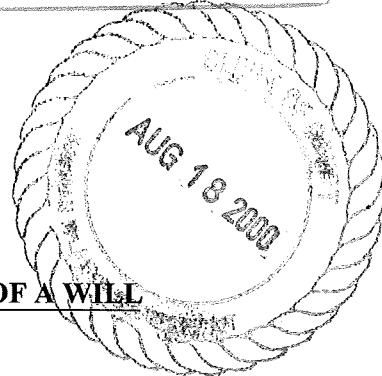

**APPLICATION FOR GRANT OF PROBATE OF A WILL**  
**(Succession Law, Section 3(7))**

- (b) within one year of such Grant to me, I will administer the said estate according to the tenor of the Will and directions, if any, of the Court and file in the Probate Registry a general account accounting for the whole of the assets of the said estate.
