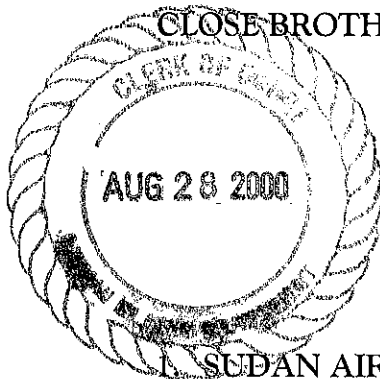

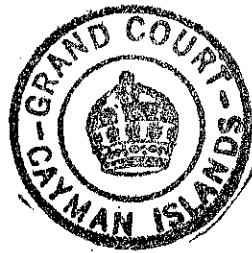

LET THE DEFENDANTS attend before the Judge in Chambers, at the Law Courts, George Town, Grand Cayman on a date to be fixed on the hearing of an application by the Plaintiff of Tolworth Tower, Surbiton, Surrey, KT6 7EL, United Kingdom that there be granted the following relief pursuant to Section 10 of the Mortgaging of Aircraft Regulations 1978, namely an Order that:

1. The Civil Aviation Authority make amendment to the Cayman Islands Register of Aircraft by deleting therefrom and cancelling all reference to the Second Mortgage numbered 086 made between the First Defendant and the Second Defendant, by virtue of which the aircraft known as a Fokker 50, Registration number VP-CSE, was charged by the First Defendant by way of second legal charge in favour of the Second Defendant.
2. There be such further or other relief that the Court thinks fit.
3. Costs.

AND LET THE DEFENDANTS within 14 days after service of this summons on them counting the day of service, return the accompanying Acknowledgement of Service to the Courts office.
