If you fail to satisfy the claim or to return the Acknowledgement within the time stated, or if you return the Acknowledgement without stating therein an intention to contest the proceedings, the Plaintiff may proceed with the action and judgement may be entered against you forthwith without further notice.

**NOTE** - This Writ may not be served later than 4 calendar months (or, if leave is required to effect service out of the jurisdiction, 6 months) beginning with the date of issue unless renewed by order of the Court.



**STATEMENT OF CLAIM**

1. On the 14th March, 2000, at about 8:41 p.m. the plaintiff was walking along Marina Drive in Prospect when she was struck and thrown over a wall by a Honda Civic motor car Registration No. 75538 owned and driven by the defendant.
2. The matters complained of were caused by the negligent driving of the defendant.

**PARTICULARS OF NEGLIGENCE**

- a. Failing to keep any or any proper look out or to observe or heed the plaintiff;
  - b. Driving too fast;
  - c. Failing to apply his brakes in time or at all or so as to steer or control his motor car as to avoid striking the plaintiff;
  - d. The plaintiff will further rely on the defendant's plea of guilty to two counts of dangerous driving in the Summary Court on the 10th August, 2000.
3. By reason of the matters aforesaid the plaintiff has suffered pain, injury, loss and damage.

**PARTICULARS OF INJURIES**

- a. Fracture to left leg ( to be detailed by medical records); and
- b. Bruises and lacerations (to be detailed by medical records)
- c. The plaintiff will rely on the medical evidence to detail the full extent of her injuries


**PARTICULARS OF SPECIAL DAMAGES**
