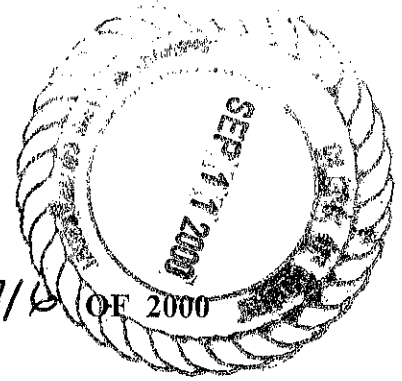

EX-PARTE ORIGINATING SUMMONS


LET ALL PARTIES CONCERNED attend before a Judge in Chambers, at the Law  
Courts, George Town, Grand Cayman on the 20 day of Sept. 2000, at 9:30  
o'clock in the noon on the hearing of an application on behalf of the Plaintiff for the  
following orders:

- (1) that the Judgement Debtor do attend before a Judge of the Grand Court, on such date  
and at such time as the court may direct, and be orally examined on the following  
questions:-
  - (i) whether any and, if so, what debts are owing to the Judgement Debtor, and
  - (ii) whether the Judgement Debtor has any and, if so, what other property or  
means of satisfying the order made by the Supreme Court of the Yukon  
Territory on the 17<sup>th</sup> day of December 1991 and registered in the Grand  
Court of the Cayman Islands on the 17<sup>th</sup> June 1999 by virtue of which the

Judgement Debtor was ordered to pay to the Judgement Creditor for the maintenance of the two children of the marriage the sum of \$250.00 Canadian per month per child beginning on the 1<sup>st</sup> day of January 1992.

- (2) That the Judgement Debtor produce, at the time and place appointed for the examination, any books or documents in his possession relevant to the debts owing to and property, if any, owned by him.
- (3) Such further or other relief as the court may direct.
