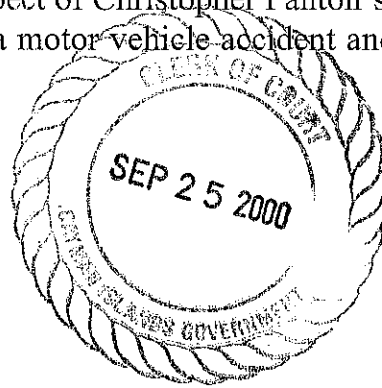
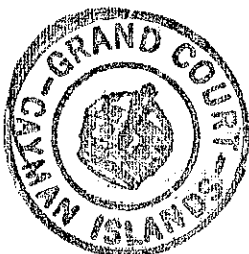

EX PARTE ORIGINATING SUMMONS

LET ALL PARTIES CONCERNED attend before a Judge in Chambers at the Law Courts, George Town, Grand Cayman, on the 5 day of Oct, 2000, at 9:30 a.m., on the hearing of an application by the Plaintiffs for:

1. An Order that Goldstine Panton and Prentice Panton be appointed as joint guardians of Christopher Panton;
2. An Order that Goldstine Panton and Prentice Panton, be appointed as joint receivers for Christopher Panton;
3. An Order that, as joint guardians of and receivers for Christopher Panton, Goldstine Panton and Prentice Panton, shall perform the following duties:
 - (a) manage, sell, acquire, charge or deal with Christopher Panton's property and apply all proceeds towards Christopher's maintenance and care;
 - (b) enter into any settlement on behalf of Christopher Panton;
 - (c) complete contracts on behalf of Christopher Panton;
 - (d) conduct legal proceedings on behalf of Christopher Panton; and
 - (e) act as trustees for Christopher Panton.
4. A Direction under Order 80, Rule 23(3) that as receivers for Christopher Panton, Goldstine Panton and Prentice Panton, need not deliver to the Court annual accounts under Order 80, Rule 23(1); and
5. An Order that Prentice Panton, as a joint guardian and receiver for Christopher Panton, be authorized to act as Christopher Panton's Next Friend and conduct such proceedings as he may be advised in the Grand Court of the Cayman Islands on behalf of Christopher Panton in respect of Christopher Panton's claim for damages for personal injuries arising out of a motor vehicle accident and for such ancillary or other relief as may be proper.
