
ORIGINATING SUMMONS

For an Order pursuant to Section 101 of the Companies Law (2000 Revision) that leave of this Honourable court be granted to RBC Dominion Securities (Global) Limited to commence proceedings against the Defendant to seek the re-payment of US\$118,993.93 being monies mistakenly paid by the Plaintiff to the account of the Defendant at Citibank in New York on or about 12th April, 1999; and that provision be made for the costs of this application as this Court deems appropriate.

AND LET THE DEFENDANT within 14 days after service of this summons on it counting the day of service, return the accompanying Acknowledgment of Service to the Courts Office.
