

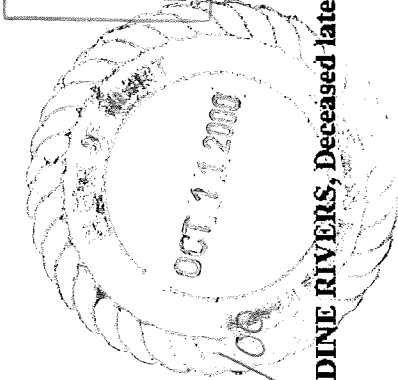

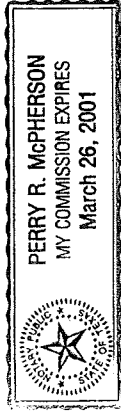
And I declare myself (and my successors) to be jointly and severally bound unto the financial secretary of the islands in the sum of US\$ 326,500.00.
