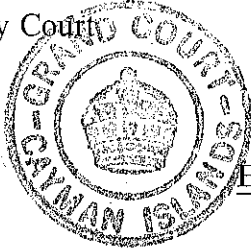

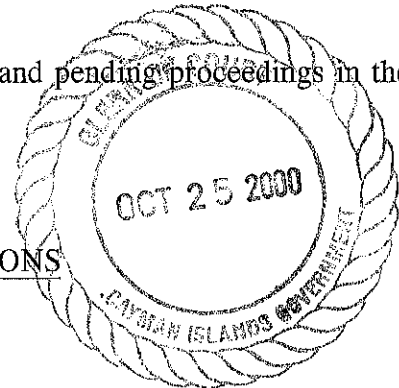

EX PARTE ORIGINATING SUMMONS




LET ALL PARTIES CONCERNED attend before the Judge in Chambers at the Law Courts, George Town, Grand Cayman on the 26th day of October 2000 at on the hearing of an application pursuant to Section 4 of the Confidential Relationships (Preservation) Law (1995 Revision) by the Joint Liquidators of Euro Bank Corporation (in Liquidation) ("the Bank") of Cardinal Plaza, PO Box 1792GT, George Town, Grand Cayman that directions be given as to whether evidence referred to herein shall be given and if so the terms upon which it shall be given.

The Applicants intend to give evidence in the form of a witness statement ("the Witness Statement") in the prosecution of Ivan Burges and others currently pending in the Summary Court. On 27th July 2000 the Grand Court made an Order in the winding up of the Bank in Cause No. 379 of 1999 that the Applicants be at liberty to prepare and supply to the Crown as requested by the Crown the said Witness Statement. The Witness Statement contains confidential information belonging to customers and shareholders of the Bank which is in the possession of the Bank either by reason of a banking relationship or in the capacity of the Bank or its subsidiaries as trustee of certain trusts and director, manager or nominee shareholder of companies. The said confidential matters to be disclosed and the matters dealt with in the

Witness Statement are set out in the affidavit of Michael Pilling intended to be sworn in these proceedings.
