- 4) That there be any such further and other relief as the Court deems just.

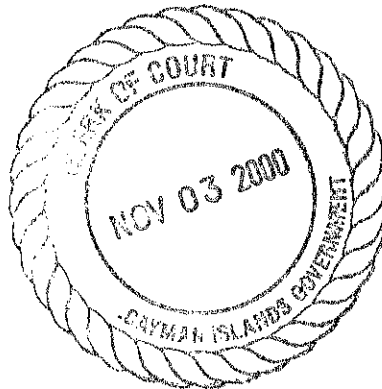
