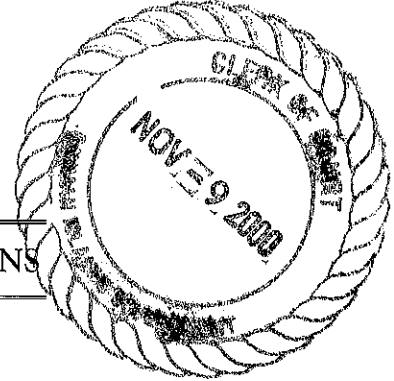

EX PARTE ORIGINATING SUMMONS
