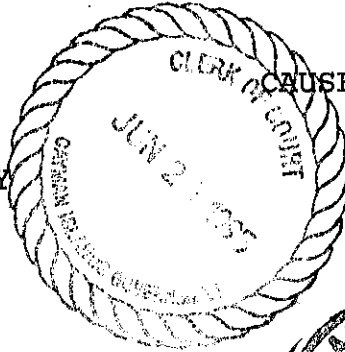

**THIS WRIT OF SUMMONS** has been issued against you by the above-named Plaintiff in respect of the claim set out on the next page.

Within [14 days] after the service of this Writ on you, counting the day of service, you must either satisfy the claim or return to the Court Office, P.O. Box 495GT, George Town, Grand Cayman, the accompanying Acknowledgment of Service stating therein whether you intend to contest these proceedings.

If you fail to satisfy the claim or to return the Acknowledgment within the time stated, or if you return the Acknowledgment without stating therein an intention to contest the proceedings, the Plaintiff may proceed with the action and judgment may be entered against you forthwith without further notice.

Issued this 26<sup>th</sup> day of June, 1995.

NOTE - This Writ may not be served later than 4 calendar months (or, if leave is required to effect service out of the jurisdiction, 6 months) beginning with the date of issue unless renewed by order of the Court.

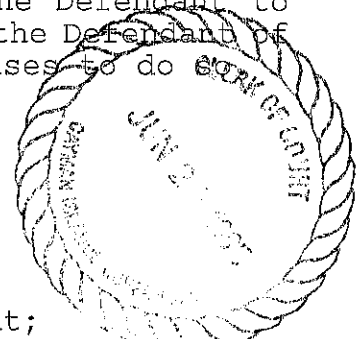

STATEMENT OF CLAIM



1. The Plaintiff's claim is for the sum of CI \$17,200.00, loaned to the Defendant by the Plaintiff;
2. Despite many requests by the Plaintiff of the Defendant, to repay to the Plaintiff the said sum loaned to the Defendant of CI \$17,200.00, the Defendant refused and refuses to do so.



AND THE PLAINTIFF claims:

1. The sum of CI \$17,200.00 loan to the Defendant;
2. Interest on the said sum at the rate of 10% interest per annum;
3. Costs and attorneys' fees.

[If, within the time for return the Acknowledgment of Service, the Defendant pays the total amount claimed of \$17,200.00 (including interest and costs) further proceedings will be stayed. The money must be paid to the Plaintiff or his/her Attorney.]

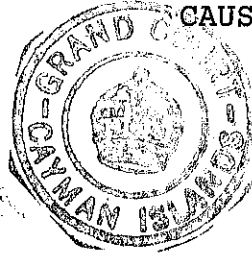

In the case of a limited company, "residence" means its registered or principal office.
