

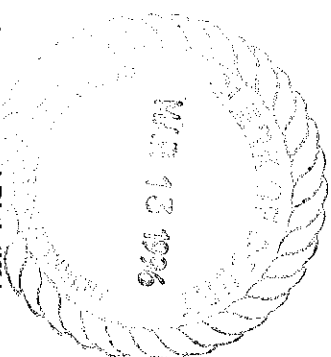

THIS WRIT OF SUMMONS has been issued against you by the above-named Plaintiff in respect of the claim set out on the next page.

Within (14 days) after the service of this Writ on you, counting the day of service, you must either satisfy the claim or return to the Court Office, P.O. Box 495GT, George Town, Grand Cayman, the accompanying Acknowledgement of Service stating therein whether you intend to contest these proceedings.

If you fail to satisfy the claim or to return the Acknowledgement within the time stated, or if you return the Acknowledgement without stating therein an intention to contest the proceedings, the Plaintiff may proceed with the action and judgment may be entered against you forthwith without further notice.

STATEMENT OF CLAIM

1. The Plaintiff, hereinafter also referred to as the "Creditor" is a bank and trust company licensed under the Bank and Trust Companies Law, with Registered Offices in the West Wind Building, P.O. Box 1097, George Town, Grand Cayman.
2. The Defendant hereinafter referred to as the "Debtor" has a postal address of P.O. Box 89, George Town, Grand Cayman.
3. The Creditor's claim is for the principal sum of CI\$9,911.41 being the balance owing on a loan account in respect of a loan extended by the Plaintiff to the Defendant on January 19, 1994 bearing interest at the rate of 14.50% per annum. The account is currently in arrears since July 1, 1995 and interest is presently accruing at a daily rate of CI\$3.85 per day. Interest due on this account to February 1, 1996 is CI\$123.20.
4. The Debtor has refused and/or neglected to pay the aforesaid amount including interest, and the same remains unpaid.


AND THE PLAINTIFF claims:

1. (a) The principal amount of CI\$9,911.41
- (b) Interest in the amount of CI\$123.20 accrued from January 1, 1996 to February 1, 1996 calculated at the agreed rate of CI\$3.85 per day.
- (c) Court costs of CI\$115.00
- (d) Attorney's fees of CI\$250.00
- (e) Intelsec Consultants Limited fees of CI\$45.00
- (f) Filing fee of CI\$15.00 for Affidavit of Service

If, within the time for returning the Acknowledgement of Service, the Defendant pays the total amount claimed of CI\$10,459.61 (including interest and costs) further proceedings will be stayed. The money must be paid to the Plaintiff or his Attorney.

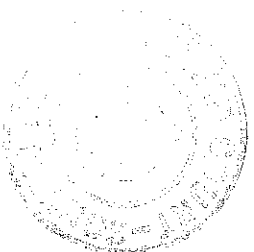

## Notes for Guidance

1. Each Defendant (if there are more than one) is required to complete an Acknowledgement of Service and return it to the Courts Office.
2. For the purpose of calculating the period of 14 days for acknowledging service, a writ served on the Defendant personally is treated as having been served on the day it was delivered to him.
3. Where the Defendant is sued in a name different from his own, the form must be completed by him with the addition in paragraph 1 of the words "sued as EMILY HOSEIN".
4. Where the Defendant is a FIRM and an attorney is not instructed, the form must be completed by a PARTNER by name, with the addition in paragraph 1 of the description "Partner in the firm of \_\_\_\_\_ " after his name.
5. Where the Defendant is sued as an individual TRADING IN A NAME OTHER THAN HIS OWN, the form must be completed by him with the addition in paragraph 1 of the description "trading as \_\_\_\_\_ " after his name.
6. Where the Defendant is a LIMITED COMPANY the form must be completed by an Attorney or by someone authorised to act on behalf of the Company, but the Company can take no further step in the proceedings without an Attorney acting on its behalf.
7. Where the Defendant is a MINOR or a MENTAL PATIENT, the form must be completed by an Attorney acting for a guardian *ad litem*.
8. A Defendant acting in person may obtain help in completing the form at the Courts Office.
