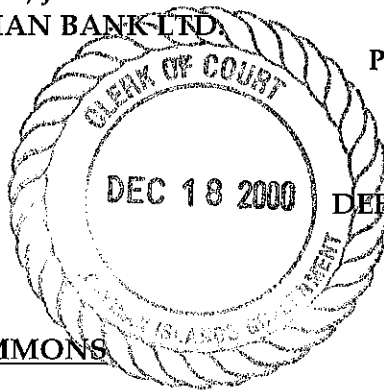


LET THE DEFENDANTS, within 14 days after service of this Summons on him, counting the day of service, return the accompanying Acknowledgment of Service to the Courts Office, P.O. Box 495, George Town, Grand Cayman.

By this Summons, which is issued on the application of First Cayman Bank (In Liquidation), c/o Deloitte & Touche, PO Box 1113 GT, Grand Cayman, the Plaintiffs claim against the Defendants the following Orders:

1. The Plaintiffs in the exercise of the powers granted to First Cayman Bank Limited (In Liquidation) under a Charge dated the 21<sup>st</sup> day of June, 1996 in respect of property described in the Cayman Islands Land Register as Property Section George Town Central, Block 13D, Parcel 217 shall be at liberty to sell the charged property by public auction or by private treaty.
2. That this Honourable Court shall give directions with regard to the price for the sale of the said property.
3. That this Honourable Court will make such further and other directions as it deems fit and appropriate.
4. That the Plaintiffs be awarded the costs of this application such costs to be paid out of the proceeds of the sale of the property.

If the Defendants do not acknowledge service, such judgment may be given or order made against or in relation to them as the Court may think just and expedient.
